Day 5 LYON - GENEVA - ZURICH

Wed

Today, we'll travel to **Switzerland**. Upon arrival in **Geneva**, we'll pass by the Palace of Nations (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and explore the pretty English Garden with its flower clock and admire the Jet d'Eau, the tallest fountain in Europe.

After lunch, we'll continue our journey through Switzerland, traveling along the scenic routes by **Lake Geneva** and **Lake Neuchâtel**. We'll drive along the Three Lakes region, enjoying views of magnificent vineyards set against the mountain backdrop. We'll stop in **Neuchâtel**, where you can enjoy a walk by the lake, explore the historic town center, or visit the beautiful 10th-century castle. Our journey will conclude in **Zurich**, where we'll arrive in the late afternoon.

Note: Depending on the number of passengers traveling from Geneva to Zurich, this part of the trip may be done by train, in which case there will be no stop in Neuchâtel.

Day 6 ZURICH

Thu

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a scenic **cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by **train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

Note: Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via public transport.

Day 7 ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

Fri

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

Note: The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.

Day 1 PARIS

Sat

Welcome to your tour with Europamundo! We'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

Day 2 PARIS

Sun

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, where a **cable car** (included) will take us up to this charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

Day 3 PARIS

Mon

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace.

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.

Day 4 PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON

Tue

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to Lyon, the former capital of Roman Gaul, located on the banks of the Rhône River. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

Note: In some cases, part of the group will stay in Chambéry, a city near Lyon. In these instances, we'll travel to Chambéry in the evening for an overnight stay. In the morning, you'll have time to visit this medieval-style city, the capital de la Savoie, known for its beautiful historic center and impressive castle.

Day 8 **ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN**
Sat

We'll leave Zurich early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **Bellinzona**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold. Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the center. Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **Como** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **Lombardy**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral. We'll continue to **Milan**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.

Day 9 **MILAN - PISA - ROME**
Sun

Today, we'll continue our journey to **Pisa**. We'll ride a small **tourist train** to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.

Day 10 **ROME**
Mon

In the morning, we'll kick off our day with a **panoramic tour**, offering a fantastic introduction to the Eternal City. We'll visit the tiny state of **the Vatican**, the heart of Christianity, where you'll have the chance to explore Saint Peter's Basilica. Tickets are included for the **Imperial Forums**, an awe-inspiring architectural complex filled with monumental buildings and squares that were once the hub of political life in Imperial Rome.

In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to Trastevere**, perfect for a leisurely stroll through its charming, narrow cobblestone streets. This district is rich in hidden gems, from quaint medieval churches and quirky shops selling unique items to everyday scenes of local life. You'll find many trattorias (casual eating establishments, typically less formal than a ristorante) and osterias (similar to taverns), each exuding Italian charm and ready to serve you authentic local dishes. Additionally, the area offers a variety of restaurants serving Indian, Chinese, and international cuisine. We'll return to the hotel at the end of the evening.

Day 11 **ROME - MADRID**
Tue

At the time informed by the guide, we will make a **transfer to the airport** to catch a **domestic flight** included in your trip. On arrival at destination we will give you another **hotel transfer**. Your guide will contact you at the end of the afternoon or you can consult the information in your hotel reception.

Note: remember that on domestic flights, the luggage normally allowed is one suitcase of up to 20 kg in the hold. Passengers must pay for all excess luggage directly to the airline.

Day 12 **MADRID**
Wed

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor. We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Admission is included to the **Santiago Bernabéu Stadium**, the home of Real Madrid—considered by many to be the best football club in the world. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.

Day 13 **MADRID - ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA**
Thu

In the morning, we'll leave for **Aragon**, travelling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **Zaragoza** to admire the stunning Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Finally, we'll head to **Barcelona**, where we'll arrive in the evening.

Day 4	ROME - ORVIETO - CASTIGLIONE DEL LAGO - SIENA Sat	Today we'll embark on an enchanting journey through the beautiful region of Umbria. Our first stop will be Orvieto , a medieval city majestically set atop a flat summit. Before entering the city, we'll pause to admire the breathtaking views from its viewpoint. We'll then ride the escalators that connect the lower part of the town with the medieval center, where we'll marvel at the cathedral, a stunning masterpiece of Italian Gothic art. The city also boasts a network of underground tunnels, once used as shelters and water reserves during times of war, that are open to visitors. Next, we'll travel to Castiglione del Lago , nestled on the banks of Lake Trasimeno. Here, you'll have time for a leisurely stroll and lunch. After lunch, our journey will continue to Sienna , Tuscany, renowned for its famous Piazza del Campo and Duomo. We'll spend the afternoon in Siena.
Day 5	SIENA - MONTECATINI - SAN GIMIGNANO - FLORENCE Sun	We'll leave Siena and make a stop at Montecatini , a magical medieval village with cobbled streets, ancient walls, and quaint little shops. Afterward, we'll continue to San Gimignano , a charming little city with tall medieval towers. After lunch, we'll travel to Florence , the capital of Tuscany, arriving in the early afternoon. We recommend an afternoon visit to the Uffizi Gallery or the Accademia Gallery (both closed on Mondays).

Day 6	FLORENCE Mon	After capturing a photo at the Michelangelo viewpoint , where we'll enjoy one of the most breathtaking views of the city, we'll embark on a guided tour of the capital of Tuscany , one of the most visited cities in the country. This city, known as the cradle of the Renaissance, has inspired some of the most influential artists and thinkers in history, such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and Raphael. We'll marvel at the Gothic Cathedral (Duomo di Firenze), the ancient stone bridge (Ponte Vecchio) with its goldsmith stores, and Piazza della Signoria, the political heart of the city with the town hall in a medieval building. Free time will follow the tour.
Day 7	FLORENCE - PISA - SESTRI LEVANTE - MONTE CARLO - BLUE COAST Tue	Departure from Florence to Pisa , with time to admire its artistic ensemble, including the famous Leaning Tower. The next stage offers extraordinary scenic beauty along the Italian Riviera. We'll arrive in Sestri Levante , a charming small resort town by the sea. There will be time for lunch and a stroll. We will then continue towards the French Riviera, arriving in Monte Carlo in the mid-afternoon, where you can visit its historic casino. Our journey will proceed to Nice , with arrival around 08:00 p.m. Please note: During this stage of our trip, there may be instances where the guide is not fluent in English.
Day 8	BLUE COAST - SAINTE MAXIME - SAINT TROPEZ - MARSEILLE Wed	Today, we'll explore the Côte d'Azur and the Mediterranean coast of France. We'll spend a short time in Nice to enjoy the <i>Promenade des Anglais</i> (Walkway of the English) and other sights of interest. Next, we'll head to Sainte-Maxime , a charming coastal town where we'll stroll through its port and historic center, highlighted by the 16th-century the Square Tower. From there, we'll take a tourist boat across the beautiful bay to Saint-Tropez , where we'll be able to see some of the world's most luxurious yachts in the old fishing port. We'll have time to stroll and have lunch. Our journey will then continue to Marseille , France's second-largest city, to visit the vibrant Vieux-Port (Old Port).

Day 11 BARCELONA - PENISCOLA - VALENCIA - MADRID

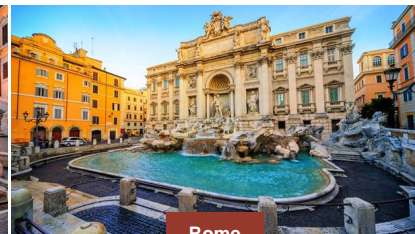

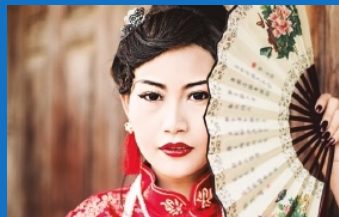
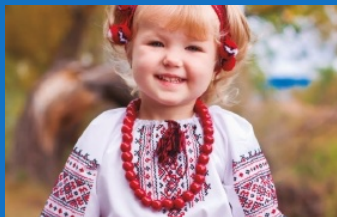
